

Holy Spirit Categories

1) Manifestations of the Holy Spirit

- a. Power - Acts 1:8 "...but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."
- b. Divinity - Omnipresent - Psalm 139:7-8 Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence?
Creator - Genesis 1:2 - The earth was formless and void, and darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was moving over the surface of the waters.
Job 33:4 "The Spirit of God has made me,
And the breath of the Almighty gives me life."
Lord who is the Spirit - 2 Corinthians 3:17-18 "Now **the Lord is the Spirit**, and **where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom**. We all, with unveiled faces, are looking as in a mirror at the glory of the Lord and are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory; **this is from the Lord who is the Spirit**.
Law of the Spirit of Life – Romans 8:2 "For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death."
- c. Voice - Hebrews 3:7-8 "Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says:

"Today, if you will hear His voice,
Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion,
In the day of trial in the wilderness,..."
- d. Intercessor - Romans 8:26 "**In the same way the Spirit also joins to help in our weakness**, because we do not know what to pray for as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with unspoken groanings."
- e. Guide - Romans 8:14 For **all who are led by God's Spirit are God's children**.
- f. Convictor of Sin – **John 16:8** "If I (Jesus) do go away, then I will send him (Holy Spirit) to you. **And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment**."
- g. Tongues – Acts 2:2-4 "And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ Then there appeared to them **divided tongues**, as of fire, and *one* sat upon each of them. ⁴ And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance."

2) Gifts of the Holy Spirit

- a. Teaching - John 14:26 “But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.”
- b. Preaching - Ephesians 6:17 - And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
- c. Various Gifts – 1 Corinthians 12:1-11 “**To each person has been given the ability to manifest the Spirit for the common good.**

To one has been given a message of wisdom by the Spirit;
to another the ability to speak with knowledge
to another faith by the same Spirit;
to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit;
to another miraculous results; to another prophecy;
to another the ability to distinguish between spirits;
to another various kinds of languages;
and to another the interpretation of languages.

- d. Wisdom, Counsel & Knowledge –

Isaiah 11:2 “And **the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.**”

Deuteronomy 34:9 “Now Joshua the son of Nun was filled with the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him; and the sons of Israel listened to him and did as the Lord had commanded Moses.”

- e. Discernment –

1 Corinthians 2:7-13

“For his Spirit searches out everything and shows us God’s deep secrets. No one can know a person’s thoughts except that person’s own spirit, and no one can know God’s thoughts except God’s own Spirit.

And we have received God’s Spirit (not the world’s spirit), so we can know the wonderful things God has freely given us. When we tell you these things, we do not use words that come from human wisdom”

3) Fruit of the Holy Spirit –

Galatians 5:22-23 “But **the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control.** Against such things there is no law.”

4) **Baptism of the Holy Spirit** –

- 1 Corinthians 12:13 “For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.”
- 1 Corinthians 3:16 – “Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?”
- Matthew 3:11 “As for me, I baptize you with water for repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, and I am not fit to remove His sandals; He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.”
- Ephesians 1:13 “In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation—having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise.”
- Acts 2:38 - “Peter said to them, “Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.”
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 “What? know ye not that your body is **the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?**”

5) **Holy Spirit Anointing** –

Luke 4:16-19 - “And as His (Jesus) custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:

“The Spirit of the LORD *is* upon Me,
Because He has anointed Me
To preach the gospel to *the* poor;
He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,
To proclaim liberty to *the* captives
And recovery of sight to *the* blind,
To set at liberty those who are oppressed;
¹⁹ To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD.”

And He began to say to them, “Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing.”

John 9:6-7 “When He had said these things, He spat on the ground and made clay with the saliva; and He anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay. And He said to him, “Go, wash in the pool of Siloam” (which is translated, Sent). So he went and washed, and came back seeing.”

2 Corinthians 1:21-22 - “Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us *is* God, ²² who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.”

James 5:14 - Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the

church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

1 John 2:20-21 “But you have an anointing from the Holy One, and you[Ⓜ] know all things. I have not written to you because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and that no lie is of the truth.

1 John 2:27 “But the anointing which you have received from Him abides in you, and you do not need that anyone teach you; but as the same anointing teaches you concerning all things, and is true, and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you[Ⓜ] will abide in Him.”

James 5:14-15 “Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.¹⁵ And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

6) Holy Spirit Filled –

Exodus 31:1-3 “Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying:² “See, I have called by name Bezalel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah.³ And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all *manner of workmanship*,

Luke 1:41 “And it happened, when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, that the babe leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit.”

Ephesians 5:17-19 “Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord *is*. And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,..”

Micah 3:8 “But truly I am full of power by the Spirit of the LORD, And of justice and might,

7) Holy Spirit Names

a. Spirit of Truth - John 16:13-14

“But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you.”

b. Helper - John 14:16 – “I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever;”

c. Advocate - 1 John 2:1 “My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous;

d. Spirit of glory (1 Peter 4:14) “If you are[Ⓜ] reproached for the name of Christ, blessed *are you*, for the Spirit of glory and of God

rests upon you.”

- e. Lord, The (2 Corinthians 3:17) “Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.”
- f. God (Acts 5:3-4)
- g. Spirit of revelation (Ephesians 1:17)
- h. Spirit of the Son (Galatians 4:6)
- i. Spirit of God (Genesis 1:2; 1 Corinthians 2:11; Job 33:4)
- j. Eternal Spirit (Hebrews 9:14)
- k. Spirit of the Lord (Isaiah 11:2; Acts 5:9)

8) Holy Spirit Poured Out –

Joel 2:28 “It will come about after this

That I will pour out My Spirit on all mankind;
And your sons and daughters will prophesy,
Your old men will dream dreams,
Your young men will see visions.”

Acts 2:32-33 “This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. Therefore being exalted ^{to} the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this (Holy Spirit during Pentecost) which you now see and hear.”

Romans 5:5 “Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been **poured out** in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Titus 3:5-6 “...not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, ⁶ whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior,

9) Holy Spirit Will Come Upon You –

1 Samuel 10:6 “Then the Spirit of the Lord will come upon you mightily, and you shall prophesy with them and be changed into another man.”

Luke 1:35 “And the angel answered and said to her, “*The Holy Spirit will come upon you*, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.”

Acts 1:8 “But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be ^{to}witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Judges 3:9-10 “When the children of Israel cried out to the LORD, the LORD raised up a deliverer for the children of Israel, who delivered them: Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb’s younger brother. ¹⁰ The Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he judged

Israel. He went out to war, and the LORD delivered Cushan-Rishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand;

- 10) **Holy Spirit Ministries** – Ephesians 4:11-14 “And He Himself gave some *to be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the ^[e]edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; that we should no longer be children,..”

11) **Seven Spirits of God -**

Revelation 3:1 “And to the angel of the church in Sardis write, ‘These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: “I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead.

Revelation 4:5 “And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire *were* burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.

Revelation 5:6: “And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are **the seven Spirits of God** sent forth into all the earth.”

Isaiah 11:2: “And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and power, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.”

The 7 Spirits of God (as in Isaiah 11:2) are the perfect completeness of the Holy Spirit:
