

Prophecies of Jesus as Promised Messiah

1) A Forerunner was to Proceed Him

“Behold, I send My messenger, And he will prepare the way before Me.
And the Lord, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple,
Even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight.
Behold, He is coming,” Says the LORD of hosts.” *Malachi 3:1*

This is *he* of whom it is written: ‘Behold, I send My messenger before Your face,
Who will prepare Your way before You.’ “For I say to you, among those born of
women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist;...” *Luke 7:27-28*

“The voice of one crying in the wilderness:
“Prepare the way of the LORD; Make straight in the desert
A highway for our God. ⁴Every valley shall be exalted
And every mountain and hill brought low;
The crooked places shall be made straight And the rough places smooth;
⁵The glory of the LORD shall be revealed, And all flesh shall see *it* together;
For the mouth of the LORD has spoken.” *Isaiah 40:3-5*

“Then they (Pharisees) said to him (John the Baptist), “Who are you, that we may give
an answer to those who sent us? What do you say about yourself?”

He said: “I *am* ‘The voice of one crying in the wilderness: “Make straight the way of
the LORD,” ’ as the prophet Isaiah said.” *John 1:22-23*

“But the angel said to him, “Do not be afraid, Zacharias, for your prayer is heard;
and your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. ¹
And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth.
For he will be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong
drink. He will also be filled with the Holy Spirit, even from his mother’s womb.
And he will turn many of the children of Israel to the Lord their God.
He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah,
‘to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children,’
and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just,
to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.” *Luke 1: 13-17*

2) He was to be Born of a Virgin

“Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign:
Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son,
and shall call His name Immanuel.” *Isaiah 7:14*

"Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. ³¹And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS. ³²He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. ³³And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

³⁴Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?"

³⁵And the angel answered and said to her, "*The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.*" *Luke 1: 30-35*

"But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. ²¹And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins."

²²So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: ²³"Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us." *Mathew 1:20-23*

"And I heard a loud voice from heaven saying, "Behold, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God Himself will be with them *and be* their God." *Revelation 21:3*

2) He was to be Born in Bethlehem

"But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, *Though* you are little among the thousands of Judah, *Yet* out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth *are* from of old," From everlasting." *Micah 5:2*

"Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, ⁵to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with child. ⁶So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. ⁷And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn." *Luke 2:4-7*

"Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem,..." *Mathew 2:1*

3) He is the Son of God

Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, And distress them in His deep displeasure:
“Yet I have set My King On My holy hill of Zion.”
“I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me,
‘You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.
Ask of Me, and I will give *You* The nations *for* Your inheritance,
And the ends of the earth *for* Your possession.
You shall break them with a rod of iron;
You shall dash them to pieces like a potter’s vessel.’ ”
Now therefore, be wise, O kings; Be instructed, you judges of the earth.
Serve the LORD with fear, And rejoice with trembling.
Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish *in* the way,
When His wrath is kindled but a little.
Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him. *Psalm 2:5-12*

“And suddenly a voice *came* from heaven, saying,
“This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” *Mathew 3:17*

“When Israel *was* a child, I loved him,
And out of Egypt I called My son.” *Hosea 11:1*

When he arose, he took the young Child and His mother by night and departed for Egypt, ¹⁵and was there until the death of Herod, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying, “Out of Egypt I called My Son.” *Mathew 2:14-15*

4) He is God in the flesh

“For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given;
And the government will be upon His shoulder.
And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God,
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
Of the increase of *His* government and peace *There will be* no end,
Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom,
To order it and establish it with judgment and justice
From that time forward, even forever.
The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.” *Isaiah 9:6-7*

There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse,
And a Branch shall grow out of his roots.
The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding,
The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.
His delight *is* in the fear of the LORD, And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes,
Nor decide by the hearing of His ears; But with righteousness He shall judge the poor,

And decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.
Righteousness shall be the belt of His loins,
And faithfulness the belt of His waist. *Isaiah 11:1-5*

“But to the Son *He* says: “Your throne, O God, *is* forever and ever;
A scepter of righteousness *is* the scepter of Your kingdom.
⁹You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness;
Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You
With the oil of gladness more than Your companions.”

And: “You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth,
And the heavens are the work of Your hands. They will perish, but You remain;
And they will all grow old like a garment; Like a cloak You will fold them up,
And they will be changed. But You are the same,
And Your years will not fail.” *Hebrews 1:8-10*

“When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him. ¹⁷And suddenly a voice *came* from heaven, saying,
“This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” *Mathew 3:16-17*

5) He was Called out of Egypt

“When Israel was a child, I loved him,
And out of Egypt I called My son.” *Hosea 11:1*

“Now when they had departed, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream, saying, “Arise, take the young Child and His mother, flee to Egypt, and stay there until I bring you word; for Herod will seek the young Child to destroy Him.”

When he arose, he took the young Child and His mother by night and departed for Egypt, ¹⁵and was there until the death of Herod, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying, “Out of Egypt I called My Son.”
Mathew 2:13-15

6) He was to have a Galilean Ministry

“And leaving Nazareth, He came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is by the sea, in the regions of Zebulun and Naphtali, ¹⁴that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:

“The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali,
By the way of the sea, beyond the Jordan,
Galilee of the Gentiles:

¹⁶The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light,

And upon those who sat in the region and shadow of death
Light has dawned.” Mathew 4:13-16

“And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.” *Mathew 4:23*

7) A King will Come

“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem!
Behold, your King is coming to you; He *is* just and having salvation,
Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey...
...He shall speak peace to the nations; His dominion *shall be* ‘from sea to sea,
And from the River to the ends of the earth.’” *Zechariah 9:9-10*

Then they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their clothes on it, and He sat on it. ⁸And many spread their clothes on the road, and others cut down leafy branches from the trees and spread *them* on the road. ⁹Then those who went before and those who followed cried out, saying:

“Hosanna! ‘Blessed *is* He who comes in the name of the LORD!’
Blessed *is* the kingdom of our father David That comes in the name of the Lord!
Hosanna in the highest!” *Mathew 11:7-10*

8) He would Govern the World

“For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given;
And the government will be upon His shoulder.
And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God,
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.” *Isaiah 9:6*

“Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One *in whom* My soul delights!
I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.” *Isaiah 42:1*

“Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” *Philippians 2:9-11*

“His delight *is* in the fear of the LORD,
And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes,
Nor decide by the hearing of His ears;
But with righteousness He shall judge the poor,
And decide with equity for the meek of the earth;
He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth,
And with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.” *Isaiah 11:3-4*

“Behold, the day of the LORD comes, Cruel, with both wrath and fierce anger,
To lay the land desolate; And He will destroy its sinners from it.” *Isaiah 13:9*

“He will not fail nor be discouraged, Till He has established justice in the earth;
And the coastlands shall wait for His law.” *Isaiah 42:4*

9) He would be a Light to the Gentiles

“I, the LORD, have called You in righteousness, And will hold Your hand;
I will keep You and give You as a covenant to the people,
As a light to the Gentiles, To open blind eyes,
To bring out prisoners from the prison,
Those who sit in darkness from the prison house.” *Isaiah 42:6-7*

“A light to *bring* revelation to the Gentiles,
And the glory of Your people Israel.” *Luke 2:32*

“Indeed He says, ‘It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant
To raise up the tribes of Jacob, And to restore the preserved ones of Israel;
I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles,
That You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.’ ” *Isaiah 49:6*

“And again, Isaiah says: “There shall be a root of Jesse; And He who shall rise
to reign over the Gentiles, In Him the Gentiles shall hope.” *Romans 15:12*

10) Nations would come Against Him

“He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.” *John 1:11*

He is despised and rejected by men,
A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief.
And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him;
He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. *Isaiah 53:3*

“Why do the nations rage,
And the people plot a vain thing?
The kings of the earth set themselves,
And the rulers take counsel together,
Against the LORD and against His Anointed, *saying*,
³“Let us break Their bonds in pieces
And cast away Their cords from us.” *Psalms 2:1-3*

“For truly against Your holy Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered together ²⁸to do whatever Your hand and Your purpose determined before to be done.” *Acts 4:27-28*

“The stone *which* the builders rejected
Has become the chief cornerstone.” *Psalms 118:22*

“Jesus said to them, “Have you never read in the Scriptures:

‘The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone.

This was the LORD’s doing, And it is marvelous in our eyes’.

“Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it. And whoever falls on this stone will be broken; but on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder.” *Mathew 21:42-43*

11) He was to be Anointed by the Holy Spirit

“There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse,
And a Branch shall grow out of his roots.
The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him,
The Spirit of wisdom and understanding,
The Spirit of counsel and might,
The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.” *Isaiah 11:1-2*

“Behold! My Servant whom I uphold, My Elect One *in whom* My soul delights!
I have put My Spirit upon Him; He will bring forth justice to the Gentiles.” *Isaiah 42:1*

“When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting upon Him. ¹⁷And suddenly a voice *came* from heaven, saying,
“This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” *Mathew 3:16-17*

12) He would Perform Miracles

“Say to those *who are* fearful-hearted, “Be strong, do not fear!
Behold, your God will come *with* vengeance, *With* the recompense of God;
He will come and save you.”
Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened,
And the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.
Then the lame shall leap like a deer, And the tongue of the dumb sing.
For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, And streams in the desert.” *Isaiah 35:4-6*

“Jesus answered and said to them, “Go and tell John the things which you hear and see: ⁵*The* blind see and *the* lame walk; *the* lepers are cleansed and *the* deaf hear; *the* dead are raised up and *the* poor have the gospel preached to them.” *Mathew 11:4-5*

“Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by **miracles**, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst, as you yourselves also know—“ *Acts 2:22*

13) He was Sold for 30 Pieces of Silver

“Then I said to them, “If it is agreeable to you, give *me* my wages; and if not, refrain.”
So they weighed out for my wages thirty *pieces* of silver. And the LORD said to me,
“Throw it to the potter”—that princely price they set on me. So I took the thirty *pieces* of silver and threw them into the house of the LORD for the potter.” *Zechariah 11:12-13*

“Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests ¹⁵ and said, “What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?” And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver. ¹⁶ So from that time he sought opportunity to betray Him.” *Mathew 26:14-16*

“Then was fulfilled what was spoken by Jeremiah the prophet, saying, “And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the value of Him who was priced, whom they of the children of Israel priced, ¹⁰ and gave them for the potter’s field, as the LORD directed me.” *Mathew 27:9-10*

14) He would Voluntarily Suffer

“He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth;
He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent,
So He opened not His mouth.” *Isaiah 53:7*

“The place in the Scripture which he read was this: “He was led as a sheep to the slaughter;
And as a lamb before its shearer *is* silent, So He opened not His mouth.
In His humiliation His justice was taken away,
And who will declare His generation? For His life is taken from the earth.”

So the eunuch answered Philip and said, “I ask you, of whom does the prophet say this, of himself or of some other man?” Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning at this Scripture, preached Jesus to him.” *Acts 8:32-35*

“But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this *is* commendable before God.

For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us,

leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps:

“Who committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth”;

who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten,
but committed *Himself* to Him who judges righteously;

who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree,

that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—

by whose stripes you were healed.” *1 Peter 2:20-24*

15) Although He had done no Violence, He was put to Death

For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken. And they made His grave with the wicked— But with the rich at His death,
Because He had done no violence, Nor *was any* deceit in His mouth. *Isaiah 53:8-9*

“For those who dwell in Jerusalem, and their rulers, because they did not know Him, nor even the voices of the Prophets which are read every Sabbath, have fulfilled *them* in

condemning *Him*. And though they found no cause for death *in Him*, they asked Pilate that He should be put to death.” *Acts 13:27-28*

“For You will not leave my soul in Sheol,
Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.” *Psalms 16:10*

16) **He was to Die as an Atonement for our Sins**

“Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows;
Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.
But He was wounded for our transgressions,
He was bruised for our iniquities;
The chastisement for our peace was upon Him,
And by His stripes we are healed.
All we like sheep have gone astray;
We have turned, every one, to his own way;
And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.” *Isaiah 53:4-6*

“For He was cut off from the land of the living;
For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.” *Isaiah 53: 8*

“By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities.
Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great,
And He shall divide the spoil with the strong,
Because He poured out His soul unto death,
And He was numbered with the transgressors,
And He bore the sin of many,
And made intercession for the transgressors.” *Isaiah 53:11-12*

“The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said,
“Behold! The Lamb of God who **takes away** the **sin** of the world!” *John 1:29*

And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: “The Deliverer will come out of Zion,
And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob; For this *is* My covenant with them,
When I take away their sins.” *Romans 11:26-27*

“For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴and that He was buried,
and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,...” *1 Corinthians 15:3-4*

“For since by man *came* death, by Man also *came* the resurrection of the dead.
For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.” *1 Corinthians 15:21-22*

“...who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.” *1 Peter 2:24*

“...that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying:

“He Himself took our infirmities And bore *our* sicknesses.” *Matthew 8:17*

17) **His Hands and Feet had to be Pierced**

"The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me.
They pierced My hands and My feet;..." *Psalms 22:16*

"And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they **pierced**.
Yes, they will mourn for Him as one mourns for *his* only son,
and grieve for Him as one grieves for a firstborn." *Zechariah 12:10*

"But one of the soldiers **pierced** His side with a spear,
and immediately blood and water came out." *John 19:34*

18) **He was Given Vinegar when He was Thirsty**

"...they gave Him sour wine mingled with gall to drink. But when He had tasted *it*, He would not drink." *Matthew 27:34*

"You know my reproach, my shame, and my dishonor; My adversaries *are* all before You.
Reproach has broken my heart, And I am full of heaviness;
I looked *for someone* to take pity, but *there was* none;
And for comforters, but I found none. They also gave me gall for my food,
And for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink." *Psalms 69:19-21*

19) **They would Cast Lots for His clothes**

"They divide My garments among them,
And for My clothing they cast lots." *Psalms 22:18*

"Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts,
to each soldier a part, and also the tunic. Now the tunic was without seam, woven from the top in one piece. They said therefore among themselves,
"Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be,"
that the Scripture might be fulfilled which says:
"They divided My garments among them,
And for My clothing they cast lots." *John 19:23-24*

20) **He would be Buried in a Rich Man's Grave**

"For He was cut off from the land of the living;
For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.
And they made His grave with the wicked—
But with the rich at His death,
Because He had done no violence,
Nor *was any* deceit in His mouth." *Isaiah 53:8-9*

"Now when evening had come, there came a rich man from Arimathea,
named Joseph, who himself had also become a disciple of Jesus.
This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus.
Then Pilate commanded the body to be given to him.

When Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock; and he rolled a large stone against the door of the tomb, and departed.” *Mathew 27:57-60*

21) **He would be Resurrected**

“For You will not leave my soul in Sheol,
Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.” *Psalms 16:10*

“Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put *Him* to grief.
When You make His soul an offering for sin,
He shall see *His* seed, He shall prolong *His* days,
And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.” *Isaiah 53:10*

“He is not here, but is risen!
Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee,
saying, ‘The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men,
and be crucified, and the third day rise again.’ ” *Luke 24:6-7*

“For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received:
that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,
and that He was buried,
and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures,
and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve.
After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once,
of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep.
After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles.
Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.” *1 Corinthians 15:3-8*

22) **He would Make a New Covenant**

“I, the LORD, have called You in righteousness, And will hold Your hand;
I will keep You and give You as a covenant to the people, As a light to the Gentiles,
To open blind eyes. To bring out prisoners from the prison,
Those who sit in darkness from the prison house.” *Isaiah 42:6-7*

“The Redeemer will come to Zion,
And to those who turn from transgression in Jacob,” Says the LORD.

“As for Me,” says the LORD, “this *is* My covenant with them: My Spirit who *is* upon you, and
My words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the
mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants’ descendants,” says
the LORD, “from this time and forevermore.” *Isaiah 59:20-21*

“Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the
house of Israel and with the house of Judah—
not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day
that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt,
My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD.
But this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days,

says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts;
and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.
No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying,
'Know the LORD,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them,
says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."
Jeremiah 31:3n1-34

"Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you." *Luke 22:20*

23) He would Return upon these Conditions:

"For, brothers, I want you to understand this truth which
God formerly concealed but has now revealed, so that you won't imagine you
know more than you actually do. It is that stoniness, to a degree, has
come upon Israel, until the Gentile world enters in its fullness; and that it is in
this way that all Isra'el will be saved." *Romans 11:25*

"And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists,
and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of
ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ, till we all come to the unity of the
faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a perfect man, to the measure
of the stature of the fullness of Christ;" *Ephesians 4:11-13*

"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the one who kills the prophets and stones those who
are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, as a hen
gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing!
See! Your house is left to you desolate;
for I say to you, you shall see Me no more till you say:
'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!' " *Matthew 23:37-39*

Just as you yourselves were disobedient to God before, but have received
mercy now because of Israel's disobedience;
so also Israel has been disobedient now, so that by your showing them the
same mercy that God has shown you, they too may now receive God's mercy.
For God has shut up all mankind together in disobedience, in order that he
might show mercy to all". *Romans 11:30-32*

"Indeed He says,
'It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant
To raise up the tribes of Jacob,
And to restore the preserved ones of Israel;
I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles,
That You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.' " *Isaiah 49:6*
